A. The Swimming Pool

The Community Swimming Pool is your pool and the use of the pool is included in your Association Fees. Each unit is provided with one pool key. Replacement keys are available for \$2.50 each. Each resident is issued one pool pass and each unit is entitled to two guest passes.

The following rules shall be posted in the swimming pool area:

- 1. The pool will normally be opened at least from Memorial Day through Labor Day.
- 2. The pool is open from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. daily. Closing time will be strictly enforced and fined and pool privileges revoked.
- 3. There is no Lifeguard. Swim at your own risk.
- 4. Only residents and up to two guests per household are permitted to use the pool.
- 5. All guests must be accompanied by a resident/homeowner.
- Residents are responsible for the actions of their registered pool users and their quests.
- 7. Children under the age of 16 are permitted in the pool area only when accompanied by a parent or other responsible adult resident. (A 17-year-old cannot accompany a 15-year-old or other minor, for example.) Parents are wholly responsible for the safety of their own children and shall watch their children in the pool or wading area at all times. Children may not enter the area until their parent or responsible adult is also in the pool area.
- 8. The pool is for the enjoyment of the entire community, adults and children. Lap swimmers should be allowed an unimpeded lane on one side of the pool. Lap swimmers should use discretion when the pool is crowded.
- 9. No diving is permitted. Running, pushing, wrestling or any activity endangering self or others in and around the pool area is forbidden. This should go unsaid, but since it's happened, make sure you're not jumping on top of someone when you enter the pool.
- 10. Excessive noise level (i.e. music, shouting) is not permitted, nor should it disturb residents nearby.
- 11. Equipment such as flotation devices, masks and fins will be restricted when the pool is crowded. They should be removed from the water when not in use. No such items can be stored at the pool or in the rest rooms.
- 12. No glass or any other breakable container is permitted in the pool area at any time.
- 13. Pets are not permitted in the pool at any time.
- 14. Smoking is not permitted in the pool area.
- 15. No alcoholic beverages are permitted in the pool area.
- 16. Proper bathing attire must be worn at all times, including children and infants. All diapers must be covered with protective pants (i.e. swim diapers) when using either pool. Accidental infant defecation is cause for immediate evacuation of the pool. The pool will be closed until it is treated for possible health hazard.
- 17. Any person in the pool area during hours when the pool is closed will be considered trespassing and the North Coventry Police will be called.
- 18. Chairs are available for your convenience and should be returned to the storage area after use. Please keep the pool area clean at all times.
- 19. Private parties, except for community parties thrown by the association, are not permitted.
- 20. The cost of any damage within the pool area will be charged to the responsible party, resident or guest.
- 21. Life preservers, water wings or other safety equipment must be used by pool users who cannot swim.
